INSURANCE:

Please note that the provision of personal accident insurance is the responsibility of the individual player. The stadium management does not accept liability for a participant's injury sustained whilst involved in competition.

RELEVANT RULES

1. Games consist of four 10 minute quarters, with a two-minute change over at half time.
2. No hair slides or combs are to be worn on court.
3. Players may 'fill-in' for other teams, however:
 - They can **ONLY** 'fill-in' for 3 games with any one team after which they must join that team for the remainder of the season.
 - 'Fill-ins' can only play on the wings eg: WA or WD.
 - 'Fill-ins' can only play the same grade or higher than they play normally.
4. Premiers for each division will be those on top of the ladder at the completion of the second last week of the season (2/9/10); all teams will play a round-robin tournament to complete the season.
5. All players must be in full uniform by the third playing date. Out of uniform players will attract a penalty of two goals per player.
6. Games will not start if unsupervised children are in the court area. Crèche facilities (The Ark) are available at \$2.50/hour. To assist in provision of this service it would be appreciated if teams could notify the Crèche Manager of the anticipated numbers of children attending.

Forfeits

In the event of a team having to forfeit, a forfeit fine will be imposed. If notification of the forfeit is received **more than 24 hours prior** to the game the fine will be only **\$25.00**. Where there is **less than 24 hours** notice, the fine will be **\$50.00**. **Forfeit fines must be paid before the next scheduled fixture.**

Min Player Tickets

Each team must purchase 7 player tickets; if your team is short of players you need to make sure they are bought.

Sportsmanship/Fair Play

An emphasis that we place on our programs is the promotion of sportsmanship and fair play. We **REQUIRE** all teams to demonstrate this.
