COSTS

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Under 14's - Must be born 1st July 1996 or after (School Years 7 & 8)

Junior Girls - A-1st July 1992 or after (School Years 10-12) **B**-1st July 1996 or after (School Years 7-9)
Players may be asked for a copy of a birth certificate to verify this.

GENERAL RULES

1. Full correct uniform is expected of all players by the third playing date (singlets numbered front and back with 4-15, 20-25, 30-35 or 40-45). Wearing incorrect singlets will incur a **FOUR POINT ADVANTAGE**, per player out of uniform, to the opposition.
2. (1) Teams must notify the Sports Office 24 hours before the game if forfeiting; **a fine of \$15 will apply.**
(2) If a team does not give 24 hours notice, **a \$30 fine will be imposed.**
3. Every player is required to purchase a ticket to play; if your team is short of players you must still purchase a minimum of 5 tickets.
4. Players need to play 5 games to qualify for finals (management has discretion).

SPORTSMANSHIP AND FAIR PLAY

An emphasis which we place on our programmes is the promotion of sportsmanship and fair play. We encourage and require you to promote this concept amongst your junior players, coaches, spectators and parents. All players and parents need to read our junior competition booklet for behaviour guidelines.

FIXTURES
